### Jon 3:3-5 A Three Day Journey

#### 1. Jonah 3:3-5:

##### A. Vs 3. ...according to the word of the LORD:

- (1) Our decisions are governed by \_\_\_\_\_ or by \_\_\_\_\_.
- (2) \_\_\_\_\_: This is the way of the “ new man” (Eph 5:8, 14-15) The Light is God’s Word (Ps 119:105) Walking in the light starts with the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord (Prov 1:7) and ends with \_\_\_\_\_ through faith. (Rom 5:2)
- (3) \_\_\_\_\_: This is the way of the old man and is \_\_\_\_\_. (1 John 2:15-17). It begins at birth (our natural state of being) and ends in death (Prov 16:25) with nothing but disappointment along the way (Rom 8:20-22, Eccles). (Not just talking about \_\_\_\_\_ sin).

##### B. Vs 4: A city of 3 days journey

- (1) Jonah was travelling from West to East.
- (2) Jonah went into the city one day’s journey and preached a message of repentance.
- (3) Next thing we know in terms of his location, we find him seated east of the city (4:5).
- (4) So, 2 days are “\_\_\_\_\_”. Compare scripture to scripture:
  - a) Eph 3:16 (and 1:10). The church age is a \_\_\_\_\_: previously unseen, now revealed
  - b) 2 Peter 3:8: If a day is as a thousand years (2 Pe 3:8), 2,000 \_\_\_\_\_ are missing.
  - c) Lev 23: Feasts of the Lord. See PP (can access it at mbtkc.org/media and MyMBT).

##### C. Vs 5: Believing God

- (1) The people of Nineveh believed God and were \_\_\_\_\_.
- (2) They were spared because what they did was based on what God \_\_\_\_\_.
- (3) Compare with John 3:16 for \_\_\_\_\_.
- (4) Compare with 1 Thess 2:13 for \_\_\_\_\_.
