## Jonah Week 7: *Jonah 1:10-13*

### Explanation:

- \_\_\_\_\_ The Sailors now know that their dilemma came from Jonah's \_\_\_\_\_.
- Conundrum: This is your fault. So, what shall we do to \_\_\_\_\_ that the sea might be calm unto \_\_\_\_\_?
- \_\_\_\_\_: Jonah: "Throw me into the sea." The sailors: Try to fight the storm.

### Consideration:

- Prophecy:
  - \* Western mind: Prophecy is a \_\_\_\_\_ Something is foretold, at some point in the future it happens. Period. The \_\_\_\_\_ is the main thing.
  - \* Jewish Mind: Prophecy is a \_\_\_\_\_; A Theme is presented. The event is simply a variation on the theme. The \_\_\_\_\_ is not the main thing.
    - Like a theme in a song. Variations on a theme occur, they may not be identical, but they are recognizable.
    - Example: Hosea 11:1 and Ex 4:22. Now see Matt 2:15. This had already been fulfilled.?. Theme is "out of Egypt So, the pattern is seen in different ways throughout scripture. ("Out of Egypt" is found 74 times in OT)"—For us, we are called out of the world. "Come out of Egypt"—easy to preach, right?
    - Rom 15:1-4—another example and our NT doctrine to apply scripture this way. See also 1 Co 9:9-10.
    - From this understanding we get our \_\_\_\_\_.
  - \* The church mind: Christ is the main thing: He is our pattern. Col 3:10.
