# Ephesians 4:21-24

*If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the the spirit of your mind; And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness*

# Nehemiah 9:29

*And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.*

# Deuteronomy 1:43

*So I spake unto you; and ye would not hear, but rebelled against the commandment of the Lord, and went presumptuously up into the hill.*






# Deuteronomy 4:33-40

than to live lavishly, a  
slave to the world*



# Hebrews 4:15

*For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.*

# 1 Corinthians 10:13

*There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.*

it slew me.*


# 1 Timothy 2:14
