- The disciples just came back from the work that Jesus sent them to do
- They were busy and it was time for them to rest
  - o Mark 6:30-31
- Jesus was interrupted, yet he had \_\_\_\_\_\_ on the people. Mark 6:34
  - They didn't have a shepherd

THE TOOL: Vs 37	
The disciples' solution for the need of the peopl	e was to send them away. Vs 37 [give] ye
them to eat – Jesus wanted	to fulfill the needs!
KEY: God desires to to n	neet the needs of the people. ●
God gave us His ministry because He desires	to use us to fulfill His ministry 2
Co 5:18; Rom 10:14-15	
THE TASK: Vs 37-44	
The disciples had men to	o feed! Mark 6:44

Their solution was:

Buying bread from the city. Vs 37
 Even then, it would not be sufficient, Philip said. Jhn 6:7

Jesus answered, vs 38 ... How many loaves have ye?...

- There were 5 loaves of bread, and 2 fishes
- Andrew's response: Jhn 6:9
