



Mark 6:34-44 – A Miracle with the Incapables

The Gospel of Mark

- Author: **Mark**
- One of the four gospels in the Bible that walks through Jesus' life on earth
- Portrays Jesus as a servant

Context

- The disciples just came back from the work that Jesus sent them to do
- They were busy and it was time for them to rest
 - *Mark 6:30-31*
- Jesus was interrupted, yet he had _____ on the people. *Mark 6:34*
 - They didn't have a shepherd
 - They didn't have a leader, someone to care for them

THE NEED: Vs 35-36

The disciples realized a need amongst the people.

The need was that the people were lacking _____ !

KEY: There is _____ among the people.

- Similarly, the people around us have a need. *2 Co 4:3-4; Rev 20:12-14*
- Do you see that there is a need?

THE TOOL: Vs 37

The disciples' solution for the need of the people was to send them away. Vs 37 ... [give] ye

them to eat... – Jesus wanted _____ to fulfill the needs!

KEY: God desires to _____ to meet the needs of the people. ●

God gave us His ministry because He desires to use us to fulfill His ministry *2 Co 5:18; Rom 10:14-15*

THE TASK: Vs 37-44

The disciples had _____ men to feed! *Mark 6:44*

Their solution was :

- Buying bread from the city. *Vs 37*
Even then, it would not be sufficient, Philip said. *Jhn 6:7*

Jesus answered, vs 38 ... *How many loaves have ye?...*

- There were 5 loaves of bread, and 2 fishes
- Andrew's response: *Jhn 6:9*

KEY: Jesus _____ where we are lacking

- *2 Co 12:9-10; Phil 4:13; Matt 28:18-20*

- Example of Moses: *Exo 4:12*
- Example of the Apostle Paul: *1 Co 15:9-10*
