### THE \_\_\_\_\_\_ HE TAUGHT / THE TEACHING PROCESS

- Matt 7:28-29 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at **his doctrine**: 29 **For he taught them** as one having authority, and not as the scribes.
- Rom 6:17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart **that form of doctrine which was delivered you**.
- I Tim 4:13 Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.
- I Tim 5:17 Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who **labour in** the word and **doctrine**.
- II Tim 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is **profitable for doctrine**, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

### THE TRUTH / \_\_\_\_\_ OF TEACHING

- Act 13:12 Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, believed, being astonished at **the doctrine of the Lord**.
- Act 17:19 And they took him, and brought him unto Areopagus, saying, **May we know what this new doctrine**, whereof thou speakest, is?
- I Cor 14:6 Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall **speak to you** either by revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or **by doctrine**?
- II Tim 4:2 **Preach the word**; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, **exhort with** all longsuffering and **doctrine**.

### TEACHING IN THE FLESH IS \_\_\_\_\_\_

- Act 22:3 I am verily a man which am a Jew, born in Tarsus, a city in Cilicia, yet brought up in this city at the feet of Gamaliel, and **taught according to the perfect manner of the law of the fathers**, and was zealous toward God, as ye all are this day.
- I Cor 1:20-21, 26 Where is the wise? where is the scribe? where is the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? 21 For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe...26 For ye see your calling, brethren, how that **not many wise men after the flesh**, not many mighty, not many noble, **are called**:

To **KNOW** your shepherd, you have to be familiar with both

## **KNOWING ONE'S MANNER OF LIFE**

#### PAUL WAS AN \_\_\_\_\_

- Act 17:1-3 Now when they had passed through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica, where was a synagogue of the Jews: 2 And Paul, **as his manner was**, went in unto them, and three sabbath days **reasoned with them out of the scriptures**...
- Act 20:18-20 And when they were come to him, he said unto them, Ye know, from the first day that I came into Asia, after what manner I have been with you at all seasons,...20 And how I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shewed you, and have taught you publickly, and from house to house,
- Act 26:4-5 **My manner of life from my youth**, which was at the first among mine own nation at Jerusalem, **know all the Jews**; 5 Which **knew me from the beginning**, if they would testify, that after the most straitest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee.
- I Thes 1:5 For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.

# HOW TO LIVE A TRANSPARENT LIFE

- Il Pet 3:11 Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness,
- Il Cor 1:12 For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that **in simplicity and godly sincerity**, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward.
