    - Pictures us in our growing leadership and walk with the Lord




- Sanballat

      "which accused them before our God day and night"


# Key Point: You have an adversary, and we better not be ignorant of him.


1 Peter 5:8 (KJV) Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
