LONGSUFFERING - GENERALLY A _____ TRAIT

- Exo 34:6 - ...The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering...
- Num 14:18 - The LORD is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression...
- Psa 86:15 - But thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering....
- Jer 15:15 - O LORD...take me not away in thy longsuffering: know that for thy sake I have suffered rebuke.
- Rom 2:4 - Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering...?
- Rom 9:22 - What if God, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction:
- I Pet 3:20 - Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.

WHY DOES GOD TEACH US LONGSUFFERING & PATIENCE?

I Tim 1:16 - Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first **Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.**

Jas 1:4 - But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be **perfect and entire, wanting nothing.**

HAS A _____	I Cor 8:1 - Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffeth up, but charity edifieth.
IS THE GREATEST	I Cor 13:13 - And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.
IS TO BE _____	I Cor 14:1 - Follow after charity, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy. II Tim 2:22 - Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
IS THE BE _____ ON	Col 3:14 - And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.
COVERS SINS	I Pet 4:8 - And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.
DOESN'T _____	I Cor 13:8 - Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away.
IS EVIDENT	Rev 2:19 - I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first.
ACCOMPANIES WORKS	I Cor 16:14 - Let all your things be done with charity.
IS _____	I Tim 1:5 - Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:
IS LONGSUFFERING IS KIND DOESN'T ENVY NOT SELF SERVING NOT BOASTFUL	I Cor 13:4 - Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,
