Jesus "despised and rejected" in Mark 14:

- Take him by craft (v1)
- Put him to death (v1)
- Betray (x7 - v10, 11, 18, 21, 41, 42, 44)
- Offended (v27, 29)
- Smite (v27)
- Deny (v30)
- Token of a kiss (v44-45)
- Laid their hands on him and took him (v46)
- Foresook him and fled (v50)
- Put him to death (v55)
- False witness against Him (v56-57)
- Proclaimed "blasphemy" (v64)
- Condemned Him to be guilty of death (v64)
- Spit on him (v65)
- Cover his face (v65)
- Buffet him (v65)
- Mocked him (v65)
- Denied (v68, 70, 72)
- Curse and swear (v7)

CHRIST ADORED

Mark 14:3-9

- Sitting at the feet of Jesus will keep you _____ with the purposes of God
 - Mary of Bethany found at the feet of Jesus three times

- Luke 10:38-42 – Sat at the feet of Jesus and heard His word (“One thing”)
 - John 11:20, 28-35 – Patiently waited till called; answered the call in haste; fell at the feet of the Lord in brokenness; moved Jesus to weep
 - John 12:1-8 – anointed Jesus’ feet with costly oil and wiped His feet with her hair (extravagant and abandoned worship)
- Criticizing ministry of the faithful will get you _____ with the purposes of God
 - Indignation and murmuring against a saint is actually toward the Lord (Exodus 16:8)
 - Obsession with money will lead to compromise in values and loyalty to God (1 Tim. 6:10; Mark 10:25; Acts 5:1-5))
 - Satan is at work to make division
 - Entered Judas (Luke 22:3)
 - Tried to sift Peter (Luke 22:31-32)
