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### STRENGTH IN SILENCE

#### **Mark 15:1-5**

- Fulfillment of prophecy - *Isaiah 53:7*
- **Keypoint:** \_\_\_\_\_ yourself to The Righteous Judge and He'll empower you to withstand the accusations of the enemy. (1 Peter 2:20-23; Romans 12:19)

### COMPROMISE IN CONTENTING

#### **Mark 15:6-15**

- **Keypoint:** \_\_\_\_\_ those around you will compromise your service to God. (Js 4:4; Gal. 1:10)
  - Examples of pleasing God over man: Prov. 29:25; Acts 4:18-20; 5:29; 1 Thess. 2:4-6

#### **Mark 15:16-20**

- **Psalm 2:1-4**

## SUPPLY IN BEARING

### **Mark 15:21-22**

- Mark 8:34 - We are called to take up our cross
- **Keypoint:** Taking up your cross means also allowing others to \_\_\_\_\_ your burdens in times of need. (Galatians 6:2)
  - God will supply for our needs
    - Example: Isaac bearing the wood for the sacrifice (Gal. 22:7-8)


## STRENGTH IN DEATH

### **Mark 15:23-41**

- **Keypoint:** Through the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus Christ, we are able to enter into the holy presence of God. (1 Tim. 2:5; Heb.4:14-16; Heb. 9:16-18)

## BOLDNESS FOR THE BODY

### **Mark 15:42-47**

- v43: "Crave" - to ask, beg; call for; desire; require
- Joseph of Arimathaea and Nicodemus grew from secrecy to boldness (John 19:38-40)
-  **Keypoint:** \_\_\_\_\_ for the body of Christ and God will give you the boldness to speak His word (Prov. 28:1; Acts 4:29-31; Eph. 6:18-20; Phil. 1:19-20; Heb. 13:6).
