




He willingly traded in the value he had in the flesh for the grace he would find in Christ for salvation.




Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: [it is] the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.



If you've not made the trade, give your life to Christ and receive his today.




